

DAILY DEVOTIONAL FRIDAY BIBLE STUDY FOR JULY 20, 2012

THROUGH THE DOOR

"Today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43, NIV)

TRUE STORY: Several years ago now, I made a trip from my home in Washington down to Santa Rosa, California to visit some friends. I was able to talk my buddy into going to the final round of a Champions Tour event. This was not easy, because the weather was downright nasty. Washingtonians are used to this sort of thing, but for my California friend the inclemency was a major hurdle.

When we arrived for the tournament—the Siebel Classic at Coyote Creek Golf Club in San Jose—the wind was blowing and about the only thing not falling from the sky was snow.
